CREDENTIALS DO'S AND DON'TS FOR REGENTS

1. Do mark your calendar. February – complete and mail credentials to Credentials Chairman.
Date due: MARCH 1. Deadline is final. No exceptions.
2. Do elect enough delegates. The number of delegates is based upon membership. The credentials sheet has the formula. *(Regent + delegates = number of delegates allowed) and you can also find in the state yearbook under bylaws, article VII, section 1, 2 & 3.
5. Do elect an Alternate for Regent, if you have elected the Vice Regent as a delegate in her own right.
6. Don't elect the chapter Regent as a delegate. The Regent has a vote simply because of her office. Her name should not appear under "Delegates".
7. Do not elect a chapter member as a delegate or alternate, if she is a voter by virtue of her position as an elected State Officer, Honorary State Regent, District Director, and Officer of the National Society whose residence is within the State. **
8. Do remember that the rules are different for Continental Congress. This form does not apply to Continental Congress.
9. Do remember to mail and/or email your form so it will be received on time. There will be no exceptions.
10. Don't hesitate to ask questions. We are here to help.
11. Do remember this is a one-time form. When submitted it is used for State Conference only. Because this is a "one time form", it is important to list as all delegates and alternates allowed. If a delegate cannot attend, the Chapter Regent may notify the Credentials Chair and move a listed alternate to fill the absent delegates position. Please contact the Credentials Chairman with questions.
