The Patriot Records Project is a new project announced at the 2015 Continental Congress held in June in Washington DC. These Revolutionary War records are being digitized at the National Headquarters and indexed by you, a DAR member, and right from your home! After the records are verified the index will be accessible on the DAR's online database, the Genealogical Research System. (GRS).

To sign up for this project all you have to do is follow these simple instructions:

1. Go to **www.dar.org/members/dar-members-section/**
2. Sign in under **Members** (State, Chapter and National number)
3. Click on **Committees** and select **Patriot Records Project**.
4. Read all information on the **National Site** regarding the project and view the video at the bottom of the page.
5. On the right side of the page select **Volunteer Now** and fill out the form and click **Select**.

You will receive an email from the National Chairman giving you instructions and your sign in information on e-Membership.

Remember to keep track of hours worked so that you can submit your volunteer hours on **Celebrate America**. And you can earn a **Patriot Records Project pin** for participating.
