

# 2020 Chapter Achievement Awards Form Update

The 2020 Chapter Achievement Awards form continues to center around volunteerism, public relations outreach, improved communications and assisting chapters that are organizing or struggling. Addition and modifications have been made to the 2020 CAA form that address areas where the National Society continues to recognize chapters for their dedication to and support of to our mission objections: historic preservation, education and patriotism.

Below are general insights into these modifications:

- Chapters are required to complete the CAA form electronically through the Chapter Master Report (CMR) **BEFORE February 1, 2021.**
- CAA levels are as follows: Level 1 = 400 points +, Level 2 = 300 points +, Level 3 = 200 points+
- National Dues: Points have been added pertaining to the Chapter Direct Payment Program.
- Under Section 4: Registrar Training Course has been added under the Training heading.
- Section 8: Chapter Contributions. Chapter Contribution deadlines are set by each State Treasurer. All chapter contributions must be sent through the State Treasurer to the Office of the Treasurer General. Deadline for funds to be received by the Office of the Treasurer General is **December 15, 2020.** To earn the 175 points, a chapter must answer YES to the Following statement:  
YES/NO: Minimum contributions to combined funds to mission areas of Historic, Educational, Patriotic and Membership/Administrative programs and funds totals \$100 or more.
- Section 9: Optional Additional Contributions. Deadline for funds to be received in the Office of Development is **BEFORE December 25, 2020.**
- 2020 Planning Guide and updated checklists are available on the Chapter Achievement Awards Committee Webpage.
- The President General will recognize the five chapters that receive the highest CAA totals at the 130<sup>th</sup> Continental Congress.
