The DAR Genealogy Preservation Committee was established by the Executive Committee on September 30, 2003. The goal of this committee is to index DAR genealogical and membership information into computerized, searchable databases.

The result of the data input by this committee's Descendants Project appears in the DAR Genealogical Research System (GRS). The GRS is a valuable tool which is being used to assist in the completion of applications.

The Supporting Documentation Project has been completed. Our amazing volunteers categorized 8.5 million documents! We have indexed all the images in the database. The Descendants Project is also winding down. Both of these projects have a handful of volunteers assigned to finish up any remaining documents, all other volunteers have been de-activated. We do not need new volunteers for either of these projects.

The DAR Genealogists are currently assessing needs for a new project. The new project will then be presented to the Executive Board for approval. Once a new project is approved we will post the information here.
