The Veterans Health Care System of the Ozarks (VHSO) consists of one Veterans Health Administrative main facility located in Fayetteville, AR, one Health Care Center (Springfield, MO) and 6 Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC) located in Jay, OK , Joplin, and Branson, MO, Ft. Smith, Ozark and Harrison, AR. VHSO offers primary care and hospital services in medicine, surgery and mental health for the 54,000 veterans who reside in Arkansas, southern Missouri and eastern Oklahoma. www.fayettevillear.va.gov
